1 - Submit

Applicants submit applications along with relevant supporting documentation to: grants@materfoundation.ie

2 - Internal Review

Application is reviewed by Grants Specialist. All applications that meet the criteria will be reviewed for approval by the Foundation's senior leadership team

3 - Committee Review

Applications will be sent to the Project Appraisal Committee (PAC) for review. **Recommendations from PAC** are sent to the Mater Hospital Foundation Board

Applications **under €5,000** will be reviewed for approval at this stage

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4 - Approval

The Mater Hospital Foundation Board meets & approves funding for the successful grant applications

5 - Accept & Report

Applicants are notified by the Grants Specialist

Grant agreements will be issued

Grant impact report due within 6 months of funding

Applications <u>over **€5,000**</u> will be reviewed for approval at this stage
